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Q: My student took the AVID Elective last year and is not in the elective this year. Does this mean that they are no longer in AVID?

A: Yes, they are still in AVID. AVID students are required to take the AVID elective at least once throughout their middle school tenure.

Q: Why does my student not have all AVID teachers and in classes with non-AVID students?

A: Many of our students are on various academic levels, requiring differentiated instruction and as a result are on different teams. Because we are moving to AVID school-wide, some students may be serviced by one, two, or more AVID teachers. By 2020, all core teachers of RMS will be AVID certified.

Q: How often will my student have a Portfolio Check?

A: Students will receive a Portfolio grade every 4 ½ weeks from their AVID teachers.

Q: What goes in the Student Portfolio?

A: Due to each content being very unique, the students will receive information on what is expected to be in each section from their AVID teacher.

Q: What is the purpose of the Student Portfolio?

A: The AVID Portfolio is an organizational tool to help students maintain notes and school work in one place. Students are expected to maintain a portfolio, which has been provided to them along with all of the necessary items needed. They are expected to keep it organized using the AVID methods they have been taught.

Q: When will my student and I receive our student and parent contract?

A: You will receive this information at Open House or in their homeroom.
